### ***What is Lightroom and how does it work?***

- **White Balance**
- **Exposure** – 4 stop range exposure adjustment
- **Clarity** – advanced contrast adjustment
- **Vibrance adjustment** - the less saturated colors will get more of a saturation boost than those colors that are already saturated
